## **Ordinance 59**

## An ordinance of the City of Badger, Minnesota, amending the city Ordinance No. 58 Entitled "<u>An ordinance licensing and regulating the sale and consumption of</u> <u>intoxicating liquor, repealing inconsistent ordinances, and providing a penalty for</u> <u>violation.</u>"

**Section 1.** Subdivision 1, entitled "Fees" of Section 4 entitled "License Fees" of Ordinance No. 58 is hereby amended to read as follows:

**Subdivision 1.** Fees. The annual fee for a liquor license shall be One thousand four hundred and no/100ths (\$1,400.00) dollars for an "on-sale" license, One hundred and no/100ths (\$100.00) dollars for an "on-sale" wine license, One hundred and no/100ths (\$100.00) dollars for an "off-sale" license, and Three hundred and no/100ths (\$300.00) dollars for a special club license.

**Section 2.** This ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and publication.
