Proposed Ordinance No. 64 Ordinance of the City of Badger, Minnesota regulating the Parking and Storing of Recreational Vehicles

a) Discussion on having company come to a home with a camper plus having your own camper. Proposed ordinance covers and explains this scenario.
Public questioning a snow trailer that hauls snowmobiles. Council stated those types of trailers are not of the livable or dwelling type so they are not included

as a recreational camping unit. Council member Corey Christianson explained this ordinance is to prevent buying property and setting up "work camps" or living without sewer and water hook up at a lot in city limits. Public questioned if permit would be charged for. Council stated the City of Badger will not be charging a fee for a permit. Public questioned if building a home on a lot and living in a recreational camping unit. Council stated if building a home this would be acceptable if following the protocol pertaining to this proposed ordinance.
